Dr. Lester called the meeting of The Villages Charter School, Inc. to order at 4:00 p.m. on March 26, 2015. Dr. Lester announced a quorum of the Directors was present and that the meeting could proceed.

CONSENT ITEMS

Dr. Lester presented the minutes of the February 26, 2015 and **UPON A MOTION** made by Mr. Borrowman and seconded by Mrs. Mathews and the unanimous consent of all Board members present, the Board approved the minutes of the February 26, 2015 meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

INFORMATION REPORTS

FINANCIAL REPORT: The Villages made no advances to the charter school in the month of February. The Consolidated Statement of Revenue and Expenses shows a net loss of (\$582,313) for the month of February and a year-to-date net income of loss \$351,750 at February 28, 2015.

Donations/Miscellaneous Revenue:

The Charter School received \$20,000 in Dollars for Knowledge donations in February. Dr. McDaniel shared that upon Mr. Steve Drake's upcoming retirement, the Dollars for Knowledge program will continue to be in place. He also expressed words of appreciation for Mr. Drake during his time in the Purchasing Department and all that he has done for the Villages and VCS.

Athletics:

The Villages made no contribution to Athletics for the month of February. The Athletics Dept. had a net loss of (\$36,739) for the month of February and a year-to-date net income of \$108, 587 (excluding coaching supplements).

Consolidated Entity/Entire Charter School:

As of February 28, 2015, the total expenditures for the charter school as a whole were under budget by 4.4%; therefore reducing the amount of Villages contributions needed.

ENROLLMENT UPDATE:

Dr. McDaniel reported a very steady stream of new applications coming in for the 2015-16 school year. We are sitting pretty close to max as for numbers projected for this current year. Enrollment projections have been turned in for next year and K-8th is pretty full; high school is projected to jump up by about 40 students.

FACILITIES UPDATE:

Dr. McDaniel reported that several projects have started. We are moving in with the scoreboard. Concrete has been poured for the storage room. The fence at the middle school is up. Everything should be completed by August 1st, 2015.

OLD BUSINESS

WELLNES POLICY UPDATE:

Dr. McDaniel explained that we are we are regularly required to update our Wellness Policy by the Division of Food, Nutrition and Wellness of Florida the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. This involves a number of things like offering P.E. and recreation, healthy snacks when having any parties or celebrations, and it has an impact on our food service department which has done a great job. We have a VCS Wellness Committee comprised of teachers, administrators, parents and students who have reviewed and updated and submitted said policy for Board approval.

UPON A MOTION by Mr. Wise and seconded by Mrs. Mathews and with the unanimous consent of all Board members present, the Board approved the proposed Wellness Policy Update.
