#### **Course Overview**

The purpose of this course is to provide instruction that enables students to accelerate the development of reading and writing skills and to strengthen those skills so they are able to successfully read and write grade level text independently. Instruction emphasizes reading comprehension, writing fluency, and vocabulary study through the use of a variety of literary and informational texts encompassing a broad range of text structures, genres, and levels of complexity.

## **Learning Goals**

By the conclusion of this course, students will be able to...

- 1. Closely read varied texts for what they say explicitly, as well as the logical inferences that can be drawn.
- 2. Analyze both literature and informational texts to examine:
  - Text craft and structure
  - Elements of literature
  - Arguments and claims supported by textual evidence
  - Power and impact of language
  - Influence of history, culture, and setting on language
- 3. Write for varied purposes
- 4. Effectively and productively communicate and collaborate with peers (from www.cpalms.org)

#### SAT

 A student may substitute a score of 430 on the SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing test OR a 24 on the SAT Reading subtest.

#### OR

#### **ACT**

 A student may substitute a score of 19 on the ACT Reading subtest OR an average of 18 on the ACT Reading AND English subtests (average of the two).
