INFORMATION REPORTS

FINANCIAL REPORT: The Villages advanced (checks written) \$1,758,200 (\$658,200 for the Middleton campus) to the charter school in October. There were \$3,460,885 of Villages contributions recognized in October. The Consolidated Statement of Revenue and Expenditures shows a net income of \$1,270,402 and a year to date net loss of \$1,914,829 at October 31, 2022.

Donations/Miscellaneous Revenue:

There were no significant donations received in October.

Athletics:

The Villages made no contribution to Athletics for the month of October. The Athletics Department had a net loss of \$38,161 for the month of October and a year to date net income of \$220,786 before Athletics staff salaries and benefits and a \$108,010 after salaries/benefits.

Consolidated Entity/Entire Charter School:

At October 31, 2022, the total expenditures for the Charter School as a whole were under budget by 9.1%; therefore reducing the amount of Villages contributions needed.

ENROLLMENT UPDATE: Dr. McDaniel explained to the board that we have about 30 students due to be unenrolled at the end of the month due to parents not having qualifying employment.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: Dr. McDaniel explained that all buildings are currently on schedule.

SCHOOL & CAMPUS REPORTS: Each building principal gave a brief update on recent and upcoming events.

OLD BUSINESS

SCHOOL RECOGNITION PLANS: Dr. McDaniel presented to the Board the School Recognition Plans.
