Course Description: Students entering into Pre-Calculus should expect a rigorous style class. Topics in this course align with the Florida Standards and include solving and/or graphing equations of the following types: linear, absolute value, quadratic, systems, polynomial, radical, rational, exponential, and logarithmic. Additional topics include those dealing with trigonometry.

Grading Policy:

Your grade consists of things such as tests, quizzes, QoD, class work, and other additional tasks.

Grade Distribution:

Quarter grades will be calculated by the following: Assessments (Tests, Quizzes, etc.) - about 70% Classwork/Math XL/Homework - about 30%

Math XL:

Consists of topics that you have done in the past and topics from the current unit.

Math XL lessons will be posted at the beginning of a unit and will need to be completed by 3:00 P.M. on your Unit Test day!

QoD's:

QoD's are what I call "Bell Ringers" or "Warm-Ups". At least one QoD will be graded per week. Notice on which day will not be given in advance. If you are absent, you will be exempt from that week's QoD grade. QoD's are important because they will review old material and practice new material. This is also a great time to practice ACT/SAT/EOC style questions and a great way to get us started when the bell rings.

SEMESTER EXAM

At the end of the second quarter, you will be given a semester exam. This exam will consist of all the material from the beginning of the year to that point.

MAKE UP WORK
