##### VHS Early College

The Villages High School is an Early College campus of Lake-Sumter State College. VHS offers 26 college courses on its campus. In the 2024-2025 school year there are 213 VHS students, 18.8% of the VHS student body, taking at least one dual enrollment college class. VHS students are taking a cumulative 4,178 college credit hours in 2024-2025.
