FOR HEAD INJURY:

Your child received a bump on the head at school today. Although the child has not displayed any of the symptoms listed below, it is recommended that he/she be watched for any of the following which might indicate some injury:

- · Severe headache
- · Visual disturbance
- · Convulsions (Seizures)
- · Unusual behavior such as confusion, irregular breathing, or dizziness
- Unusual drowsiness or harder to wake up than usual
- Nausea and/or vomiting
- · Loss of muscle coordination such as falling, walking strangely or staggering
- · Bleeding or discharge from the ear

Contact your family physician or Emergency Room if you notice any of the above symptoms.
