The Villages High School is an "A" rated comprehensive high school serving students in grades 9-12. VHS opened in 2003 and is part of The Villages Charter School which is a Charter in the Workplace school accredited by Cognia. VHS is focused on academic achievement and preparing students for successful entry into college or directly into the workplace.

### VHS Early College

The Villages High School is an Early College campus of Lake-Sumter State College. VHS offers 30 college courses on its campus. In the 2025-2026 school year there are 256 VHS students, 21.8% of the VHS student body, taking at least one dual enrollment college class. VHS students are taking a cumulative 4,778 college credit hours in 2025-2026.
