## Dual Enrollment College Courses, Calculators & Supplies

### COLLEGE ALGEBRA

- You will need a scientific calculator. The TI-30XS Multi View is recommended by the college (LSSC); however, just about any scientific calculator will suffice. Ask me about calculator approval.
- **No graphing calculators or DESMOS**

### PRECALCULUS, TRIGONOMETRY & CALCULUS

- You will be allowed to use a graphing calculator on some tests but not all. When a graphing calculator is not permitted, you may use a 4-function calculator or possibly a scientific calculator. The TI-84+ graphing calculator is recommended by the college (LSSC) when a graphing calculator is allowed. No DESMOS, TI-89, TI-Nspire, or TI-92 graphing calculators are allowed. If you use another brand of calculator, such as Sharp or Casio, it needs to be approved by your instructor; also, make sure you have an instruction manual to use. **IF YOU BUY A NEW GRAPHING CALCULATOR, PLEASE MAKE SURE IT IS APPROVED BY YOUR INSTRUCTOR BEFORE YOU OPEN THE PACKAGE AND SAVE YOUR RECEIPT!**

### ELEMENTARY STATISTICS

- A graphing calculator is **REQUIRED** for this course. The TI-84+ is the recommended graphing calculator. The Elem. Stats. Text has instructions on how to use the TI-84+ calculator. If you use a different calculator, then make sure you have the user manual to look up processes. **No DESMOS, TI-89, TI-Nspire, or TI-92 graphing calculators are allowed. If you use another brand of calculator, such as Sharp or Casio, it needs to be approved by your instructor. IF YOU BUY A NEW GRAPHING CALCULATOR, PLEASE MAKE SURE IT IS APPROVED BY YOUR INSTRUCTOR BEFORE YOU OPEN THE PACKAGE AND SAVE YOUR RECEIPT!**
