### MIDDLETON CAMPUS

Please review both sides of this page for all supplies needed for the school year.

Students should have the following items (stored in their **BACKPACKS**) for all classes **EVERY DAY**:

- Chromebook (fully charged)
- Wired earbuds/headphones - no Bluetooth or connectivity capability. Plain ear-bud type headphones to plug into the Chromebook (to be used daily)
- Computer mouse - A wireless mouse is allowed, but **not required**
- Blue or black ink pens\*
- Expo Marker (blue or black)\*
- Pencils\*
- Highlighters: green, blue, yellow, orange and pink\*
- Coloring Supplies (crayons, colored pencils and markers)

\*These items will likely need to be replenished throughout the year

- 1 - 1" Binder (any color) filled with notebook paper
- 1 - 4 pack of dry erase markers (any colors - to be left in classroom)
- 1 Package of #2 pencils (to be left in classroom)

- 1 Package of 3x5 index cards

- 1 Pack of pencils (given to teacher)
- 1 - 100 count Pack of lined index cards
