The Villages High School is an Early College campus of Lake-Sumter State College. VHS offers 30 college courses on its campus. In the 2026-2027 school year there are 234 VHS students, 17.9% of the VHS student body, taking at least one dual enrollment college class. VHS students are taking a cumulative 4,830 college credit hours in 2026-2027.
